Trout Lake is in the south part of Hermon, St. Lawrence Co. and is about five hundred feet higher than the railroad at DeKalb Junction and is twelve miles distant. The air is cool and bracing, the scenery beautiful and picturesque and the fishing unsurpassed.

The Lake is a clear, quiet body of water, three miles long by one mile wide, dotted with numerous little islands, with rock bound shores, covered with beautiful groves of original timber. Nature has lavished her brightest smiles upon this little spot.
